Waste Water Treatment Phosphorus Study

The Indiana Department of Environmental Management has established new rules for Phosphorus Effluent from Waste Water Treatment Plants. Currently the Yorktown Treatment Plant did not have to treat for Phosphorus but because of the new regulations we will need to retool the treatment plant. This will not become a requirement until our next permit renewal 2017, but because of the amount of time needed to study and make appropriate changes to our plant I am recommending that we have BF&S start the preparation now. In addition our Chlorine Contact building is need of repair and we are looking to add this to the project.
