

YORKTOWN TOWN COUNCIL

Monday, August 22, 2016 @ 5:30 P.M.

Present: Bob Flanagan, Dan Flanagan, Lon Fox, Rick Glaub, Bob Ratchford, and Rich Lee.
Laura Vise absent.

Claims, \$306,082.92: Dan Flanagan made the motion to allow and Bob Flanagan seconded. The motion to allow purchases was voted in favor by all council members present.

Meeting Minutes: July 18, 2016. Dan Flanagan made the motion to accept minutes and Bob Ratchford seconded the motion. All council members present voted in favor.

Pavement Solutions, \$49,844.75 (LRS); E&B Paving, \$116,300 (MVH): Town Manager Olson stated that he received quotes from Pavement Solutions and E&B Paving for Crack Seal, Slurry Seal and Paving. The amounts were as follows: Crack Seal \$31,000, Slurry Seal \$18,844.75 and Paving \$116,300. Dan Flanagan made the motion to allow and Rick Glaub seconded. The motion carried by a unanimous vote of all council members present. Paving will be between Eucalyptus & River Rd on CR 500W.

INDOT contract: Ped/Bike Path, River Rd: INDOT 80/20 contract for a pedestrian/Bike Path from River Rd to St Rd 32 via Nebo Rd would not exceed \$300,000. Dan Flanagan made the motion to allow and Bob Ratchford seconded. All members present voted in favor.

Vacation Accrual of Days: There was discussion about how to calculate vacation time for employees. If an employee has 120 months (10 years) they are eligible for 3 weeks vacation. There will be an audit of employee vacation schedule to be certain all have received what they have earned.

Public Comments: John Mogush: Comprehensive Zoning? Mr. Olson stated that there will be a steering committee gathered to discuss.

Mike Blanch & Bruce Woloski: Both gentlemen asked if motor vehicles are allowed on trails? Rich Lee stated that the YPD are to take action on this. Vehicles are not allowed on trails. There was also discussion about the need for arrows along Nebo Rd @ River Rd for better traffic flow. There was discussion about the Mounds Greenway. Dan Flanagan and Rich Lee stated that they did not have enough information to say if they were for or against. Rick Glaub supports Greenway.
