Meeting was called to order by Jon Myrick @ 5:30 pm.

OLD BUSINESS

Park plan edits for the proposed park plan. We received computer generated changes to the original plan that was presented, although a representative from the company was not present. There were several items we agreed with others that we did not. Money and time line was some of the issues. Could the employees of Yorktown do the work? Some items listed included items to be completed at the building owned by J.A.A. Also Munciana owns the building and then leases a portion of it to Yorktown. The butterfly way station has been completed. We continue to create information for the public, education and outreach.

NEW BUSINESS

New member for the Park Board will be chosen by Rich Lee, President of the Town Council.

Lion's Club Park Trail: This trail will be more than a mile to mile and a half, covered with mulch, making it the longest "soft" trail in Indiana. Also there will be educational signage along the trail.

Touch-a-truck: On Friday, August 25, 2017 there will be the touch-a-truck event in Morrow's Meadow, beginning @ 4 p.m. This event is for the entire family, allowing children to access to the trucks, farm equipment, heavy machinery, helicopters, emergency vehicles, etc.

Westside Church of Christ requested the use of the small pavilion near White River for August 12, 2017. Permission granted.

Other Items: The next movie night presented by Mutual Bank is Friday, August 18th. The movie, The Beauty and the Beast begins at dusk. There will be primary painted cardboard "cars" there also.

The next scheduled meeting of the Park Board is Wednesday, September 13, 2017, in the Field Operations Building, beginning at 5:30 p.m.
