ORDINANCE NO. 724

TOWN OF YORKTOWN, INDIANA An Ordinance Abolishing the Yorktown Town Court

WHEREAS, Yorktown Town Court was established in 1975 by Ordinance No. 156, and has functioned since that time under the powers and terms set forth in that ordinance and in INDIANA CODE §33-35-1-1 et seq.

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the costs of maintaining the Court outweigh the benefits.

WHEREAS, the enabling ordinance provided that the Court could be abolished by ordinance.

WHEREAS, INDIANA CODE does not require that the Yorktown Court continue to exist.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council as follows:

- 1. Ordinance No. 156, which created the Yorktown Town Court shall no longer be in effect, and the Town Court created by that Ordinance is abolished effective December 31, 2014.
- 2. The jurisdiction of cases filed and to be filed in that Court shall be established or transferred to the Delaware County Circuit Court System and/or to the Muncie City Court.
