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Waste Water Treatment Plant Improvements

Due to various new environmental requirements the town must make some improvements to the waste water treatment plant. In addition to these new requirements, due to the age of the plant and some of the mechanical parts it is the appropriate time to look at rebuilding treatment process areas that are in excess of 30 years old. These areas include but are not completely limited to the primary treatment basins, headworks (grit collection areas) and chlorine contact areas.

BF&S has put together a proposal for the project, the first step is to get a PER done as this project will more than likely qualify for State Revolving Loan Fund dollars. This will allow the town to take advantage of lower interest rates and possibly a longer term than the traditional bond of 20 years. In addition to this to help save cost, the PER will evaluate the use of a design build strategy similar to the strategy that the town utilized for extending sewer main pipe to park 1 which helped reduce the cost of the project 10-20%.
