

ORDINANCE NO. 780

**A PROPOSAL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FEES FOR POLICE
DEPARTMENT ACCIDENT REPORTS AND MAKING THEM AVAILABLE ONLINE**

Whereas, the Yorktown Police Department routinely processes many requests for accident reports; and

Whereas, an opportunity for administrative efficiency exists by contracting with a service to maintain those accident reports online, making them more readily available to the public; and

Whereas, the Town Council of the Town of Yorktown may fix a fee for providing those reports; and

Whereas, pursuant to Ind. Code 9-26-9-3(b)(3), the funds collected by the Town for the accident reports should be deposited into the police department's continuing education fund;

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Yorktown, Indiana as follows:

The following language shall be added to §35.30 (A):

Police Department	Accident Report - Online	\$12.00
Police Department	Accident Report - In-Person	\$15.00

§35.32 ACCIDENT REPORT FUND shall be deleted in its entirety. The Clerk-Treasurer shall move the funds, if any, in this deleted fund to the Local Police Continuing Education Fund.

The Town Marshal is authorized to enter into a contract with a company to provide this online service, provided the contract does not exceed a cost per report to the Town of Five Dollars (\$5.00).

All language not shown as being amended in the foregoing Ordinance shall remain as written and in full force and effect. In the case of any conflicts, this Ordinance shall control.
