

Ordinance # 783

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A LOCAL ROAD & BRIDGE
MATCHING GRANT FUND**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Yorktown now determines it to be in the best interests of the Town of Yorktown and its taxpayers that a Local Road & Bridge Matching Grant Fund be established.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF YORKTOWN, INDIANA,

Section 1. There is hereby established a Local Road & Bridge Matching Grant Fund for the purpose of accounting for state and local funds to be used for specific road projects in the Town of Yorktown.

Section 2. The Yorktown Town Council may authorize the expenditure of funds from the Local Road & Bridge Matching Grant Fund by appropriations made in the same manner as other municipal funds.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
