

Proposal to Rework Floor at the Fire Station

Issue

Currently we are having an issue with wear and tear of the main areas and offices of the station. The flooring we have currently is 1 x 1 tile flooring that has suffered the wear and tear of 20+ years of dealing with fire service traffic and abuse.

Proposal

Have a flooring contractor install an epoxy-based floor within the station area that is meant to be able to take the abuse and wear and tear we put on it. We have requested quotes, but the companies quote that we provided is the only one that showed up to the station to provide a quote. Along with that they are local.

Rationale

The rationale for this project is to update the interior of the station living areas from where it currently is and put in a solution that will have a long lasting lifespan.

Cost

Total costs will be no more than \$26000.00.

We feel this quote will best suit the needs and address the current issues we have with the floor. This solution will entail an epoxy being put down, a chip set and then a clear coat to ensure extended wear.

Summary

By implementing the above listed updates, it will address the wearing and aging floor. It would be in our opinion the most cost-effective solution at this time.
