

ORDINANCE NO. 870

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL TOWN OF YORKTOWN, INDIANA
ESTABLISHING A HAZARDOUS MATERIALS RESPONSE FUND**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Yorktown, Indiana, now determines it to be in the best interests of the Town of Yorktown and its taxpayers that a Hazardous Materials Response Fund be established.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF YORKTOWN, INDIANA,**

Section 1. There is hereby established a fund for the purpose of accounting for revenue and proceeds received by the Yorktown Volunteer Fire Department including but not limited to services charges received for hazardous material cleanups, fuel spills, and chemical or hazardous material-related fires.

Section 2. Proceeds from this fund shall be used only for the purchase of supplies and equipment for providing hazardous materials emergency assistance and training of department members on this type of assistance, or for any other lawful purpose as set forth in IC 36-8-12.2-8 as may be amended from time to time.

Section 3. The Fund will be non-reverting and perpetual until terminated by action of the Town Council.

Section 4. Expenditures will be appropriated and approved by the Town Council according to Indiana Code, the Department of Local Government Finance, and the State Board of Accounts.

Section 5. The Clerk Treasurer will comply with all rules and regulations for record keeping according to Indiana Code and the State Board of Accounts.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage. Approved and adopted by the Town Council of Yorktown, Delaware County, Indiana, on this ____ day of _____, 2026.
