TOWN COUNCIL OF YORKTOWN, INDIANA

RESOLUTION CONCERNING ELECTED OFFICIAL WAGE AND BENEFITS

WHEREAS, the Town Council and Clerk-Treasurer of Yorktown, Indiana as the elected officials who represent the citizens of Yorktown, Indiana, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Council and Clerk-Treasurer of Yorktown, Indiana desire to show financial self-discipline to the citizens of Yorktown, Indiana, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Council and the Clerk-Treasurer of Yorktown, Indiana are elected to serve the people of Yorktown, Indiana and not themselves, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Council and the Clerk-Treasurer of Yorktown, Indiana desire to maintain the lowest possible tax rate in Delaware County, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Council and the Clerk-Treasurer of Yorktown, Indiana understand that benefits of serving the Town in the roles of Elected Officials, should not include benefits which are not available to all citizens or businesses in Yorktown;

NOW THEREFORE LET IT IS RESOLVED, that the Town Council and Clerk-Treasurer of Yorktown, Indiana, agree and pledge that for as long as they serve as an elected official of Yorktown, Indiana they will not vote for or accept an increase in their pay for their official duties;

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Council and Clerk-Treasurer will not vote for or accept a benefit from the Town of Yorktown, Indiana which is not already provided to the elected officials of the town as of March 16, 2010. This shall include health insurance benefits for board members, club memberships or other benefits which may be paid by the tax payers of Yorktown, Indiana;

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be binding on all whom sign it for as long as they serve as an elected official for the Town of Yorktown, Indiana.
