Pledge of Allegiance

Town Council members present: Bob Flanagan, Steve Fields, Laura Vise, Rick Glaub and Bob Ratchford.

Approve Meeting Minutes: Oct 15, 2012 Regular and Executive: Approve: Moved by Bob Flanagan, Bob Ratchford stated that he would like amend the meeting minutes. The minutes shall be changed to state that "Bob Ratchford stated 3 times that not one person sitting on the council asked for the investigation to take place by the State Police. It is a matter of public record that a complaint was filed." Also amended would be the statement "The administrative leave would be with full pay, by recommendation of council's attorney until further notice." Bob Flanagan made the motion to accept with the amendment and Laura Vise seconded. Council members Steve, Laura, Bob and Bob voted in favor. Rick Glaub voted no.

Approve Claims for November Motion: Approve, Moved by Laura Vise, Seconded by Rick Glaub. All town council members voted in favor.

Old Business: Buck Creek: New Agreement:

Pete Olson stated that Flatland Resources had prepared an agreement. Pete recommended that Component 1 and 2 be accepted by the council. The project involves mitigating stream impacts along Buck Creek in Morrow's Meadows Park. This is as a result of improper installation of concrete blocks to prevent stream erosion by the town several years ago. Laura Vise made the motion to accept the agreement and Bob Flanagan seconded the motion. The motion carried by a unanimous vote of all council members.

Visitor Presentation: Kelly Schrock, Community Foundation:

Ms. Schrock discussed the foundation and what it was set up to do for communities. Established in 1999 the foundation has a \$58,000 endowment that supports community events and groups. Applications are being taken now through May for approval in June for the upcoming year's endowments.

New Business: Ord 698 Zoning Powers Urban/Rural: Ord 699 Zoning Enforcement Pete Olson stated that these ordinances address zoning and zoning enforcement for the newly consolidated town and township. The rural sections of the community had been handled by the County and the urban was handled by the town. These ordinances state that the will be administered by the Building and Zoning Commissioner for the Consolidated Community. The zoning laws for the County will be enforced as it is currently and town zoning laws will be enforced as it is currently. Town Attorney Steve Murphy stated that he believed that the ordinances should be acted upon by the new council in 2013. Councilman Steve Fields stated that he would like to pass this now and

have the township board pass it also. This will allow for it to be in place for January 1. Steve Fields made the motion to introduce the ordinance and Bob Flanagan seconded. The council voted unanimously to introduce.

Consent to Encroach: Pete stated that there had been a garage built in a stormwater easement and the homeowner is selling the property. The issue is dallying the selling of the property and the homeowner has petitioned the Town of Yorktown for a partial vacation of the easement. Pete stated that there is enough room for the town to work on the stormwater utility even with the garage where it is if something were to happen to the stormwater lines. Rick Glaub made the motion with the caveat that the town may have to work on the lines at some point to begin the process of the vacation. Bob Flanagan seconded the motion and the motion carried by a unanimous vote.

Pavilion Rentals: Park Board requested that the rates change for rental of the large pavilion from \$75 to \$90 and the non-profit rentals from \$30 to \$40. The small pavilions would not change. The justification for the increase is for repairs that may be needed. Bob Flanagan made the motion to adopt and Laura Vise seconded the motion. Rick Glaub voted no and all other council members voted in favor. Motion carried by a 4 to 1 vote.

Munciana Building Lease: The lease between the Town and Munciana Volleyball had been agreed upon in 2010 for 7,233.38. There was no paperwork available to verify this. Meeting minutes state that the agreement had taken place. The original contract was not for this amount. There were additional soft costs that were added to the agreement. i.e. meeting space, bathrooms, YMCA area. To clarify the issue there was a motion by Laura Vise and a second by Bob Flanagan to accept the contract. Steve Fields stated that the Munciana facility benefits Yorktown but is a burden on taxpayers. All council members voted in favor of the contract except for Steve Fields, he voted no. Motion carried by a 4 to 1 vote.

Full Time Zoning Administrator: Pete Olson stated that he would like to move Matt Ray the part-time B&Z administrator to a full time position due to the consolidation. Rick Glaub made the motion and Bob Flanagan seconded. All members present voted in favor.

Resolution 2012-4 New Ykt Community Council: Steve Fields stated that the Consolidation plan called for the name of the community to be the "Yorktown Community Council" He stated that it reflects all areas of the community. The township entered into the consolidation believing that it was a true consolidation. Council members Ratchford and Vise stated that they believe that there is no difference when the just "Yorktown" is used. Town Attorney Steve Murphy stated that the issue can wait until 2013 when all community leaders would be in office to make the decision. Laura Vise made the motion to table and Rick Glaub seconded the motion. The motion carried by a 4 to 1 vote with Steve Fields voting against tabling.

Chipper Purchase: No action taken.

Ord 700 Establish a Community Service Fund:

Clerk Treasurer Neff stated that due to the consolidation there would need to be funds created for proper accounting and spending of money that would come into the town for certain purposes. The Community Service Fund is designated to provide assistance to needy families. Council member Steve Fields recommended that there be some wording changes specifying the area's affected by the taxation required to fund the fund. Steve Fields made the motion to amend the ordinance and seconded by Laura Vise. The motion to amend was unanimously passed.

Ord 701 Establish a Fire Building Debt Fund:

The Fire Building Fund is designated to provide payments for debt that was incurred by the Township prior to consolidation. Council member Steve Fields recommended that there be some wording changes specifying the areas affected by the taxation required funding the fund and that there would be a sunset clause added to the fund. Steve Fields made the motion to amend the ordinance and seconded by Laura Vise. The motion to amend was unanimously passed.

Ord 702 Establish a Fire Department Fund:

The Fire Department Fund is designated to provide funding for the volunteer fire department. Council member Steve Fields recommended that there be some wording changes specifying the area's affected by the taxation required to fund the fund. Bob Flanagan made the motion to amend the ordinance and seconded by Laura Vise. The motion to amend was unanimously passed.

Ord 700, 701, and 702 Adoption: Bob Flanagan made the motion to accept these ordinances as amended and Steve Fields seconded. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

Steve Fields made the motion to suspend the rules and Bob Flanagan seconded. The motion carried by a unanimous vote of all council members.

Bob Flanagan made the motion to adopt and Steve Fields seconded. All council members voted in favor.

Instituform Tech: Sewer Lining Contract: This contract was presented in the November meeting. The council requested that the contract should include a liquidated damages clause. Pete Olson stated that the clause was added. Bob Flanagan made the motion to approve the contract and Laura Vise seconded. The motion carried by a unanimous vote. Contract amount: Base Bid 94,835. And alternate bid: 61,829.

Forest Hills Neighborhood Association donated \$100 to the police department.

Special claims were presented. Peerless \$675.00 for inspections, Sherry Labs \$1,945 for water testing, and Mt Pleasant Twp Trustee \$88,035.75 for fire department quarterly contract. Bob Flanagan made the motion to allow and Laura Vise seconded the motion. The motion carried by a unanimous vote of all council members.

Pete Olson recommended that the police department being allowed to roll over vacation days for 90 days after the first of the year. This is due to 1 officer on sick leave, 2 officers on administrative leave after a bank robbery investigation leaving the department short staffed. Rick Glaub made the motion and Laura Vise seconded the motion. The motion carried by a unanimous vote of all council members.

Public Comments: There were thank yous for the work that officers Ryan Jaromin and Jeff Wulff had done during the First Merchants Bank robbery. There was discussion about the Munciana contract and how expensive it is to community. The contract was approved at a public meeting and made it binding. There was discussion about what boards and commissions were going to be opened at the beginning of the New Year. Pete Olson stated that the information would be on the town's website.

Laura Vise stated that the Munciana contract only binds the town, not the township for the monthly payments.

ORDINANCE No. 698

(CONSOLIDATED) TOWN OF YORKTOWN, INDIANA

REGARDING PLAN COMMISSION AND ZONING ISSUES

RECITALS:

- 1. Effective January 1, 2013, the Consolidated Town has come into existence, to be known as the "new" Town of Yorktown, Indiana ("Town"). The Plan of Reorganization ("Plan") recognizes that Districts will exist in the Town.
- 2. The Town District, as defined in the Plan at page 9, had an existing Zoning Ordinance as well as a Plan Commission and a Zoning Administrator.
- 3. The Rural District, as defined in the Plan at page 9, had been governed by the Delaware County Zoning Ordinance.
- 4. The Town desires to establish which Planning and Zoning laws apply to the Districts, to determine the jurisdiction of the Plan Commission, and to determine how the Zoning Ordinances shall be enforced.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDAINED as follows:

- 1. The Zoning Ordinance which applied to the former Town of Yorktown (now the Town District) shall remain in effect for the Town District.
- 2. The new Town of Yorktown shall establish a rural district which shall continue to be governed by the same language rules and regulations as the Delaware County Zoning Ordinance.
- 3. The Yorktown Plan Commission, with membership to be determined by the new Town Council shall be the study and advisory committee to the new Town Council who shall have overall jurisdiction over the Planning and Zoning rules/regulations and enforcement shall be performed by the Yorktown Zoning Administrator.

1. Except as to ordinances amended by the Plan of Reorganization (e.g. Section 11.01, Section 12.01, and Section 30.03), and except as to ordinances pertaining to Land Usage (Title XV, Chapters 150, 151, 152, 153 and 154) which are covered by a separate new Ordinance (No. 698), all other ordinances shall apply to the (Consolidated) Town in its entirety, and shall be enforced by the Town Marshal and/or the Sheriff of Delaware County, as set forth more particularly in an ordinance previously enacted by the Town.

Capital Assets

We are updating our Capital Assets policy to fall in line with accounting standards. This will reduce the amount of items that we call capital assets which is beneficial to our Fixed Assets policy.

ORDINANCE 703

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORD 354 FIXED ASSET CAPITALIZATION POLICY

Be it ordained by the Yorktown Town Council, Delaware County, Indiana so desires to amend Ordinance 354 as follows:

Section 1. MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT:

The definition of machinery and equipment is: an apparatus, tool or conglomeration of pieces to form a tool. The tool will stand alone and not become part of a basic structure or building.

The New Community of Yorktown will capitalize and tag items with an individual value equal to or greater than \$5,000. Machinery combined with other machinery to form one unit with a total value greater that the above mentioned limit will be one unit.

Shipping charges, consultant fees, and other cost directly associated with the purchase, delivery or set-up, (including contractors and/or Town workers (salary and benefits), which makes such equipment operable for its intended purpose will be capitalized.

Improvements or renovations to existing machinery and equipment will be capitalized only if the result of the change meets all of the following conditions:

- 1) total cost exceeds \$5,000,
- 2) the useful life is extended two or more years, and
- 3) the total costs will be greater than the current book value and less than fair market value.

Examples include:

A work truck being equipped with screens, lights or radios for use as a single unit throughout its life expectancy is considered one unit.

If police cars are constantly changing light bars or radios to other vehicles, the Town will capitalize each piece of equipment separately, if it meets the required dollars amount.

A department's computer (CPU, monitor, keyboard and printer) is considered one unit.

A department will record donated machinery and equipment at fair market value on the date of transfer with any associated costs.

Purchases made using Federal or State funding will follow the source funding policies and above procedures.

2013 Salary Ordinance

I've attached the proposed salary ordinance for 2013. In it I'm recommending a 2% salary increase for the employees as a cost of living adjustment. Cost of living is traditionally based off of the consumer price index (currently 2.2%) and employment cost index (currently 1.8%) and I've attached both.

The Marshal's department does a 3 year adjustment instead of an annual adjustment.

I did not increase wages for the Elected Officials & Town Manager.

I am awaiting a recommendation from the Township for the community assistance position.

Ordinance No 705

An ordinance establishing salaries and wages for the various officers and employees for the Town of Yorktown, Inc.

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Town Council or the Town of Yorktown, Delaware County, Indiana that said employees of said Town shall receive and be paid salaries and wages in accordance with the following schedule for the year 2013.

Shift is determined by what shift you are primarily assigned to by Chief. Shift pay will pertain to the officer's primary shift assignment.

If the officer looses a Tech Pay or Shift Pay the officer will forfeit the remaining pay and will not receive any form of prorated pay.

Tech Pay Schedule:

- Tech Pay I YPD Tactical Team member will receive an additional \$400.00 per year.
- Tech Pay II Officers with an Associates Degree, Property Room Officer, or Evidence Technician officer will receive an additional \$600.00 per year.
- Tech Pay III An instructor in two or more areas receives \$800.00 per year. The officer must have obtained the Instructor Development Course from the Indiana Law Enforcement Academy.
- Tech Pay IV Officers with Bachelors Degree, SMART Officer, SWAT member, Training Supervisor, & Department Investigator receives \$1000.00 per year.

Shift Pay:

- Midnights will receive an additional \$300.00 per year.
- Afternoons will receive an additional \$600.00 per year.

Rank Pay:

• Sergeants receive and additional \$600.00 per year.

Technical Duties Pay is paid in addition to the base pay rates to the members assuming the duties of the assigned position. By department policy the Chief and Assistant Chief are not eligible for Technical Duties Pay. Additionally department policy restricts members from receiving Technical Duties Pay for more than two positions.

Section 2. Additions:

Longevity Pay

All full time elected officials and employees covered by this ordinance shall receive longevity pay according to the following schedule:

1-5 years	\$200.00 per year	17-20 years	\$800.00 per year
6-11 years	\$400.00 per year	Over 20 years	\$1,000.00 per year
12-16 years	\$600.00 per year		

The payment for longevity pay shall be in two payments. One half of the longevity pay will be paid with the first pay period of the year and the second half will be with the first pay period in the month of July.

Clothing Allowance

For all full time street-utility-maintenance employees the sum of \$300.00 shall be paid as a clothing allowance. There shall be one (1) payment made in the second pay week of the month of January.

New employees starting after January will have the payment prorated according to the time employed. Payment shall be made from the appropriate funds and shall be declared as income and stated on the employee's W-2 Form.

Employee Wellness Program:

Individuals qualified for the Town of Yorktown Health Insurance shall be eligible to receive additional monetary compensation in accordance to the performance in the Employee Wellness Program. Participation levels will be monitored by the Employee Wellness Committee and recommendations will be made to the Town Manager and Clerk Treasurer for the disbursement of compensation according to the Employee Wellness Plan. Employees will have an opportunity to earn a maximum of \$750/year for participation in the Employee Wellness Program.

Deferred Compensation Retirement

The Town shall enroll the Town Manager in a qualified 457 deferred Compensation Program in accordance to the Employee Agreement with the Manager.

Section 3.

As of January 2012 all newly hired employees are responsible for 30% of group health insurance premiums. Additionally employees hired after January 2012 are responsible for the 3% employee share of the Indiana Public Employees Retirement Program (PERF).

Section 4.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect beginning the first pay in January 2013 following passage and adoption by the Yorktown Town Council.

Section 5.

Approved and adopted by the Town Council of Yorktown, Delaware County, Indiana, on this 17th day of December 2012.

CONSUMER PRICE INDEX – OCTOBER 2012

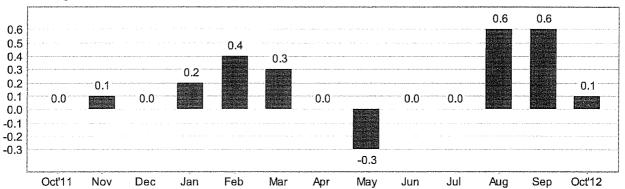
The Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) increased 0.1 percent in October on a seasonally adjusted basis, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported today. Over the last 12 months, the all items index increased 2.2 percent before seasonal adjustment.

The shelter index increased 0.3 percent, its largest increase since March 2008, and accounted for over half of the seasonally adjusted all items increase. The index for all items less food and energy rose 0.2 percent, as the rise in the shelter index and increases in the indexes for apparel and airline fare more than offset declines in the indexes for used cars and trucks, new vehicles, and recreation.

The food index increased 0.2 percent in October with the index for food at home rising 0.3 percent, its largest increase since September 2011. The energy index, which had risen sharply in August and September, declined slightly in October. Major energy component indexes were mixed, with declines in the indexes for gasoline and natural gas more than offsetting increases in the indexes for electricity and fuel oil.

The 12-month change in the index for all items was 2.2 percent in October, an increase from the September figure of 2.0 percent. The 12-month change in the index for all items less food and energy remained at 2.0 percent. The food index rose 1.7 percent over the last 12 months, and the energy index increased 4.0 percent.

EMPLOYMENT COST INDEX - SEPTEMBER 2012

Compensation costs for civilian workers increased 0.4 percent, seasonally adjusted, for the 3-month period ending September 2012, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported today. Wages and salaries (which make up about 70 percent of compensation costs) increased 0.3 percent, and benefits (which make up the remaining 30 percent of compensation) increased 0.8 percent.

Civilian Workers

Compensation costs for civilian workers increased 2.0 percent for the 12-month period ending September 2012. In September 2011 the increase was also 2.0 percent. Wages and salaries increased 1.7 percent for the current 12-month period, essentially unchanged from a year ago when wages and salaries increased 1.6 percent. Benefit costs increased 2.6 percent for the 12-month period ending September 2012 down from the September 2011 increase, which was 3.2 percent.

Private Industry Workers

Compensation costs for private industry workers increased 2.0 percent over the year. In September 2011 the increase was 2.1 percent. Wages and salaries increased 1.8 percent for the current 12-month period. The increase for the 12-month period ending September 2011 was 1.7 percent. The increase in the cost of benefits was 2.3 percent for the 12-month period ending September 2012, down from the September 2011 increase of 3.3 percent. Employer costs for health benefits increased 3.0 percent over the year. In September 2011 the 12-month increase was 3.4 percent.

Among occupational groups, compensation cost increases for private industry workers for the 12-month period ending September 2012 ranged from 1.7 percent for production, transportation, and material moving occupations and service occupations to 2.4 percent for sales and office occupations.

Among industry supersectors, compensation cost increases for private industry workers for the current 12-month period ranged from 0.8 percent for leisure and hospitality to 3.7 percent for information.

State and Local Government Workers

Compensation costs for state and local government workers increased 1.8 percent for the 12-month period ending September 2012. In September 2011 the increase was 1.5 percent. Since June 1982 12-month increases have ranged from 1.3 percent to 9.6 percent. Wages and salaries increased 1.1 percent for the 12-month period ending September 2012, essentially unchanged from a year earlier when the increase was 1.0 percent. Since June 1982, 12-month increases have ranged from 1.0 percent to 8.5 percent. Benefit costs increased 3.2 percent in September 2012. In September 2011 the increase was 2.5 percent. Since June 1990, 12-month increases have ranged from 1.2 percent to 8.3 percent.

The Employment Cost Index for December 2012 is scheduled to be released on Thursday, January 31, 2013, at 8:30 a.m. (EST).

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT CONCERNING IMPROVEMENTS TO THE INTERSECTION OF NEBO ROAD AND JACKSON STREET

This Interlocal Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") is entered
into by and between the following political subdivisions of the State of Indiana (collectively
referred to as the "Parties"): Delaware County, Indiana ("County"), the City of Muncie ("City")
and the Town of Yorktown ("Town"), on this day of

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the various portions of the intersection of Nebo Road and Jackson Street are located on real estate owned and maintained by County, City, and Town; and

WHEREAS, the County, City, and Town have determined that it would be in the best interest of their citizens and the public at large, to redevelop the intersection as doing so would better accommodate increased traffic and better insure the safety of persons traveling through the area; and

WHEREAS, the County, City, and Town agree that such redevelopment of the aforementioned intersection would be mutually beneficial to all entities involved; and

WHEREAS, the County, City, and Town have thus agreed to share the financial burden of such redevelopment equally; and

WHEREAS, the County, City, and Town have determined that entering into the Agreement, and sharing the burden of the redevelopment of the intersection of Nebo Road and Jackson Street will conserve precious public resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, the County, City, and Town hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The Parties do hereby agree to equally share the burden of financing the Engineering, Construction, and Construction Inspection of a roundabout at the intersection of Nebo Road and Jackson Street (the "Project").
- 2. The Parties agree that the effective date of this agreement shall be the date upon which all Parties have affixed their signatures, hereto.
- 3. Furthermore, the Parties agree to fully cooperate with one another and with third parties in the pursuit of public and/or private funds to assist in the financing of all stages of the Project, whenever such funds are available.
- 4. Whatever if any financial assistance is acquired from sources other than the Parties shall be equally shared between the Parties, as is the overall burden of the Project.
- 5. Additionally, the Parties agree that this agreement shall automatically terminate upon, either: a) the completion of the Project or b) the fourth (4th) anniversary from the effective date of this agreement.
