### **SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 1**

## Supplemental Engineering Services for Canal Street Project

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, made and entered into this							
day of, 2019, by and between the Town of Yorktown, Indiana, acting by and							
through the Town Council, hereinafter referred to as the "TOWN" and Butler, Fairman and							
Seufert, Inc., Indianapolis, Indiana, Consulting Engineers, hereinafter referred to as the							
"ENGINEER".							

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2018, the TOWN entered into an Agreement with the ENGINEER for services required for development of Contract Plans for the Yorktown Redevelopment.

WHEREAS, Section 6, Changes in Work, of the General Provisions state that in the event of a substantial change in the scope, the maximum fee payable and the specified fee shall be adjusted, and

**WHEREAS**, a portion of the work to be performed under the original design scope, Appendix "A" will be amended to incorporate the following additional services:

#### Right-of-Way Engineering

Revise the right-of-way limits for the project, develop additional right-of-way engineering documents over and above the number of right-of-way engineering parcels for partial acquisitions, and modify previously-development right-of-way engineering documents to account for shifted right-of-way linework, as summarized on attached Exhibit A, and

#### Right-of-Way Acquisition

Perform right-of-way acquisition services in accordance with attached Exhibit A, and

#### Water Line Design Revisions

Engineering services as required to address unforeseen revisions to the proposed Right of Way and/or Property Lines, which require design modifications to accommodate the

new water main construction along Canal Street, Vine Street, and near the intersection of Plumb Street and Canal Street.

## Road Design Revisions

Engineering services required to redesign the proposed road and sidewalk in order to accommodate existing homes that will remain and to keep the work within the modified partial right-of-way acquisition, including the addition of drives and sidewalk connections where needed, and

## **Private Utility Design Revisions**

Utility coordination services required to adjust the locations of proposed private utility relocations to stay within available rights-of-way, and to accommodate existing properties to remain indefinitely, and

# **Electric Conversions Quote Package**

Assemble quote package for the conversion of AT&T building and Speedway to bring facilities up to current electric code to be compatible with new underground electric service, and

### **Town Hall Design Revisions**

Engineering services required to adjust the Town Hall drainage design as necessary to provide temporary drainage in advance of the future storm sewer system being constructed, provide a jointing detail for the concrete parking, and revise the design of the parking lot to add a connection to Speedway.

WHEREAS, the parties hereto agree that the ENGINEER shall cause to be made the amended and additional work at lump sum costs as follows:

WHEREAS, the parties agree that the original agreement be modified by this Supplemental Agreement No. 1; therefore, the amended compensation for design engineering services and the addition of right-of-way services shall increase the not-to-exceed amount of this Agreement by \$168,080.00 from \$198,750.00 to a not-to-exceed amount of \$366,830.00.
