Riley Run Section B Primary Plat Review:

Matt Ray presented a petition for the primary plat of Riley Run Section B. This would join the roads of Sandal Wood and Lake Forest Drive.

Mark Thurston, the developer of the subdivision, stated that the original plat of Riley Run called for 61 more houses on the remaining 15 acres. It was later discovered that there are certified wetlands located in the wooded area which put the plat on hold. In light of that this new section joins the two roads in a horseshoe with 16 additional lots. The price range for these new homes will be \$200,000 to \$300,00.
