## **RESOLUTION NO. 2021-12**

## RESOLUTION DECLARING AN AREA WITHIN MT. PLEASANT TOWNSHIP/YORKTOWN, INDIANA AS AN ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION AREA

## (MUNCIE POWER PRODUCTS, INC.)

WHEREAS, <u>MUNCIE POWER PRODUCTS</u>, INC., (the "Company") has requested that the **Town of Yorktown**, **Indiana/Mt**. **Pleasant Township** (**Town Board**) approve a ten (10) year Real & Personal Property tax deduction for property improvements and added equipment to be completed by the Company;

WHEREAS, the Company has advised the Town Board that it intends to improve Real Property and add Personal Property at <u>2500 N. Priority Way, Yorktown, Indiana 47396</u> further described in the map attached hereto as Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, the Company has requested that the Town Board designate the location as an Economic Revitalization Area (an "ERA") for purposes of permitting such deductions;

WHEREAS, the Company shall submit to the Town Board an Application for Abatement, Statement of Benefits for Real & Personal Property in connection with the property as well as all information and documentation necessary for the Town Board to make an informed decision;

WHEREAS, the Town Board, as the Fiscal Body of the Town and Township, is the Designating Body authorized under the provisions of I.C. 6-1.1-12.1-1 et seq. (the "Act") to designate areas of the Town as an ERA for the purposes described herein; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has considered the application submitted by the Company and has conducted a complete and proper investigation of the Real Estate & Personal Property and determined that the area qualifies as an ERA under Indiana statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS FOUND, DETERMINED, AND RESOLVED by the Town Board of Yorktown, Indiana:

- 1. That the estimated value of the Real Estate & Personal Property is reasonable for a project of this nature.
- 2. That the benefits associated with the project can reasonably be expected to result in improvements to the property, town and township.
- 3. That the totality of benefits from the proposed project is sufficient to justify a Real & Personal Property tax deduction.
- 4. That all of the conditions for the designation of the ERA and all of the requirements for the tax deductions to be granted hereby, have been, or will be, met.

- 5. That all of the foregoing findings are true and all information required to be submitted has been, or will be, submitted in proper form.
- 6. That notice shall be published according to law stating the following: the adoption and substance of this Resolution, that a copy of the description of the affected area is available for inspection in the County Assessor's Office, and the date on which the Town Board will hold a public hearing to receive and hear remonstrances and objections from interested persons, all as required by law.
