3. Rest room in Morrow's Meadow is not clean. Suggest to check daily Monday through Friday and clean as needed.
4. Suggested putting a Splash Pad in the Lion's Club Park.
5. Working on having a regular "movie night" for families to attend.
6. Need drinking fountains for people and also for dogs.
7. Weed eat in areas that a mower unable to mow.
8. Need handicap accessible equipment: NOTE: The Community Foundation is presently working on providing handicap equipment.

Community Garden: Erin Hurley stated she would oversee the garden this year.

Butterfly Habitat: Greg Holzer and his class have applied for a grant and will know by March 1, 2017 if it was awarded to them. Plan to use a non-mow area, which will have a 6 foot wide strip mowed and in that area he plans to plant Red Bud trees plants that will attract Monarch Butterflies. Plan to label trees with stakes that have been angled. Jon Myrick will auger the holes for the posts. Seeds have been ordered for the plants.
