**TOWN OF YORKTOWN**

**ORDINANCE REGARDING LEAVING PETS  
OUTSIDE IN EXTREME CONDITIONS**

WHEREAS, this Ordinance proposes to add a new Section to Title 93 of the Code of Ordinances, to be identified as Section 93.08.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Yorktown, that it shall be unlawful for any person to place or confine any domestic animal under such conditions for such periods of time as may cause suffering or endanger the health or well-being of the animal due to extreme temperatures or lack of food or water. Dogs shall not be left outdoors alone in temperatures below twenty degrees (20°) Farenheit or above ninety degrees (90°) Farenheit, or during a wind chill advisory or heat advisory.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that a person who violates this provision shall be punishable under Section 10.99 of this Code.
